The category of these hotels, which feature a fully-fledged spa on their premises, range from one to five stars, so their services, customers and atmosphere differ greatly.

Generally, those with fewer stars tend to focus more on traditional therapeutic spa experiences. Meanwhile, the most luxurious hotels typically integrate modern and recreational elements, offering a blend of aesthetic treatments, well-being and relaxation programmes, alongside preventive or curative therapies for any type of condition tailored to the properties of their mineral-medicinal waters.

Both types of hotel usually open their facilities to hotel guests and non-hotel guests. Moreover, all spas, irrespective of their rating, are required to offer treatments under the supervision of a doctor, who determines the appropriate duration and techniques to achieve effective treatment.

Unveiling a rich history dating back to Roman times, these waters have captivated locals for centuries. From the first excavations in 1716, unearthing ancient stone basins for hot springs and natural springs, to the evolution of medicinal baths in wells in 1764 where bathers would immerse their bodies, the legacy of this thermal treasure has endured.


Since then, the spa has evolved, with small buildings open to thermal bathers, military personnel, as well as serving as a shelter for the poor. In 1817, under medical supervision, the waters were recognised for their medicinal properties.

After a period of neglect, the Count of Torre Penela acquired the natural springs in 1851, opening a simple spa that operated until the end of the 19th

century. In 1928, the waters were declared of public utility, and in 1930, according to Eugenio Carré Aldao's account, it was already an accredited spa.

Today, Balneario de Carballo emerges as a modern sanctuary, blending cutting-edge technology with expert medical guidance from a director and their team of assistants, and offers hotel facilities. In 2007, it received the prestigious "Q" quality mark for its spa and hotel facilities.

Located in the heart of Carballo, the capital of the region of Bergantiños, the spa is eight kilometres from the spectacular Razo beach and within easy reach of A Coruña as well as Santiago de Compostela, the heart of pilgrimages. Its convenient location beckons exploration of other destinations such as the Verdes Natural Area or the charming villages of Costa da Morte, as well as the "O Camiño dos Faros" route, a wonderful 200-kilometres hike split into several routes, that runs along the coastline of Costa da Morte to Finisterre.

Nestled within the tranquil residential area of O Tremo, Brión, this contemporary spa graces the historic spring of *Nuestra Señora de Los Ángeles*. Originally known as *Balneario de Los Ángeles* or *Balneario "Do Tremo"*, this haven has enchanted visitors since 1813, as documented by historical records and testimonies like that of George Borrow in his renowned work, "The Bible in Spain" of 1843.

The spa's avant-garde architecture and harmony was designed by the esteemed architect César Portela at the end of the 20th century, nestled amidst a 2,000m² century-old oak grove. 



The Termarium is a space for spa therapies featuring exclusive design and innovative techniques, where you can enjoy aromatic baths, jacuzzis, cabins, contrast pools, aromatic showers or heated chairs. 



Caldelas de Tuy boasts three centuries of history and is mentioned in the works of Pedro Gómez de Bedoya y Paredes in 1675. The Termas de Cuntis date back at least to Roman times, from which the town itself derives its name. References to its existence and the therapeutic virtues of its waters abound in writings from the 17th and 18th centuries. However, it wasn't until the late 19th century that commercial exploitation began, marked by the construction of the first spa hotel. Since that time, and under the name of "Hotel Balneario La Virgen", it has operated continuously, even during the Civil War, and has remained in the hands of the Campos family since the last century.

In 2000, Termas de Cuntis underwent a renovation, transforming its old spa into a modern, luminous complex spanning 2,600 m². Four years later, the addition of the Acquaform leisure-thermal circuit further enhanced the offerings, featuring indoor and outdoor swimming pools, a counter-current area, swan necks, jets, hydromassage beds, jacuzzis, sauna and an ice cabin.
